ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Each application will be considered for the scholarship award, but only one scholarship will be awarded to a qualified applicant. Qualifications will be based on character, academic achievement and involvement in civic and/or church activities. Completed applications will be evaluated by an impartial panel comprised of members of the Pelion Chapter #189. The scholarship chairman shall properly notify all applicants regarding the results. The recipient will also be notified of the date and place of the awards presentation. A certificate will be presented to the recipient, and monies will be distributed when proof of registration from the college or university is received. IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO FORWARD SUCH PROOF TO THE SCHOLARSHIP CHAIRPERSON.

To be considered for a scholarship the applicant must:

- 1. Be a woman under the age of 25.
- 2. Be a resident of the Hellenic Community of the greater Orlando Metropolitan area residing in the region represented by the Daughters Chapter #189 and have a member of immediate family in the Daughters or the Order of Ahepa currently in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years OR be a member of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church, Maitland, Florida for a minimum of two (2) years.
- 3. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. Be a high school senior, recent high school graduate or equivalent, applying for admission to a trade school, community college or a 4 year college or university, or an undergraduate at the college level. This is to include GED recipients as well as graduates and high school seniors. College undergraduates must have completed a minimum of one full semester (or two full quarters). The minimum number of hours per completed semester shall be twelve (or eight per quarter).
- 5. Prepare a typewritten essay of 500 words in English, "Tell us about a time you had a set back, and what lesson you learned from it." ALSO. List participation in the Daughters of Penelope, church, extracurricular, civic and community activities, and honors and awards received.
- 6. Provide a sealed official transcript of high school grades.
- 7. Provide a sealed official transcript of college grades, if a college freshman ,sophomore, or junior.
- 8. Provide a sealed letter of recommendation on official stationery from a clergy_member, teacher, professor,_or_counselor_
- 9. Provide a passport size photo.
- 10. Complete Daughters of Penelope Pelion Chapter #189 Scholarship Application.
- 11. Place items in 9 x 11" or 10 x 12" envelope and send **postmarked no later than May** 1st, 2024
